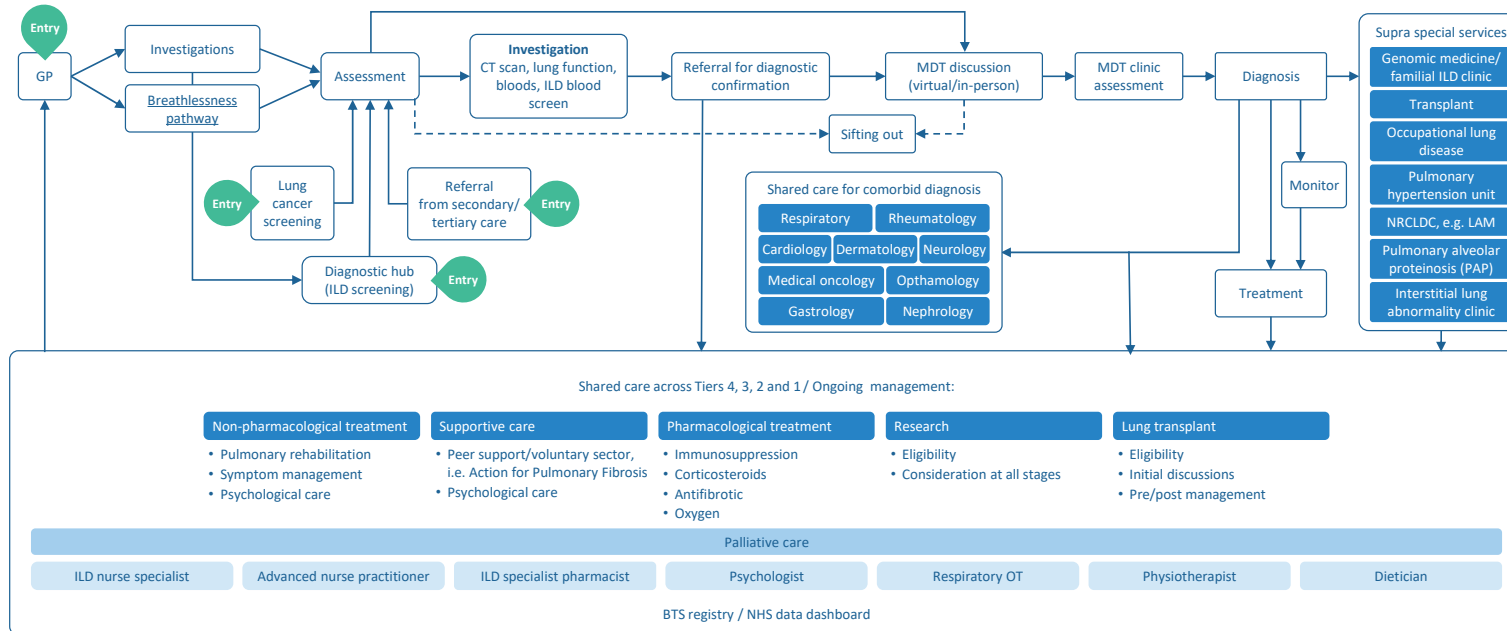

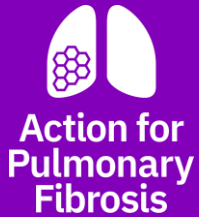
Tier 1/General local respiratory

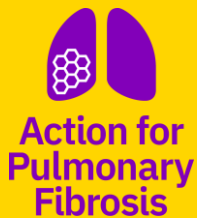
