





Supportive Care	Percentage of patients who can access with no issues	Main issues	
Pulmonary rehabilitation	73%	Majority report long waiting times and lack of PR tailored to ILD patients	
Oxygen	82%	Some areas do not offer (HOSAR) oxygen services which impacts patients, hospital service and increases waiting times	
Palliative care	91%	Some services provide in-house palliative care. Provision in local areas variable until patients access hospice support.
