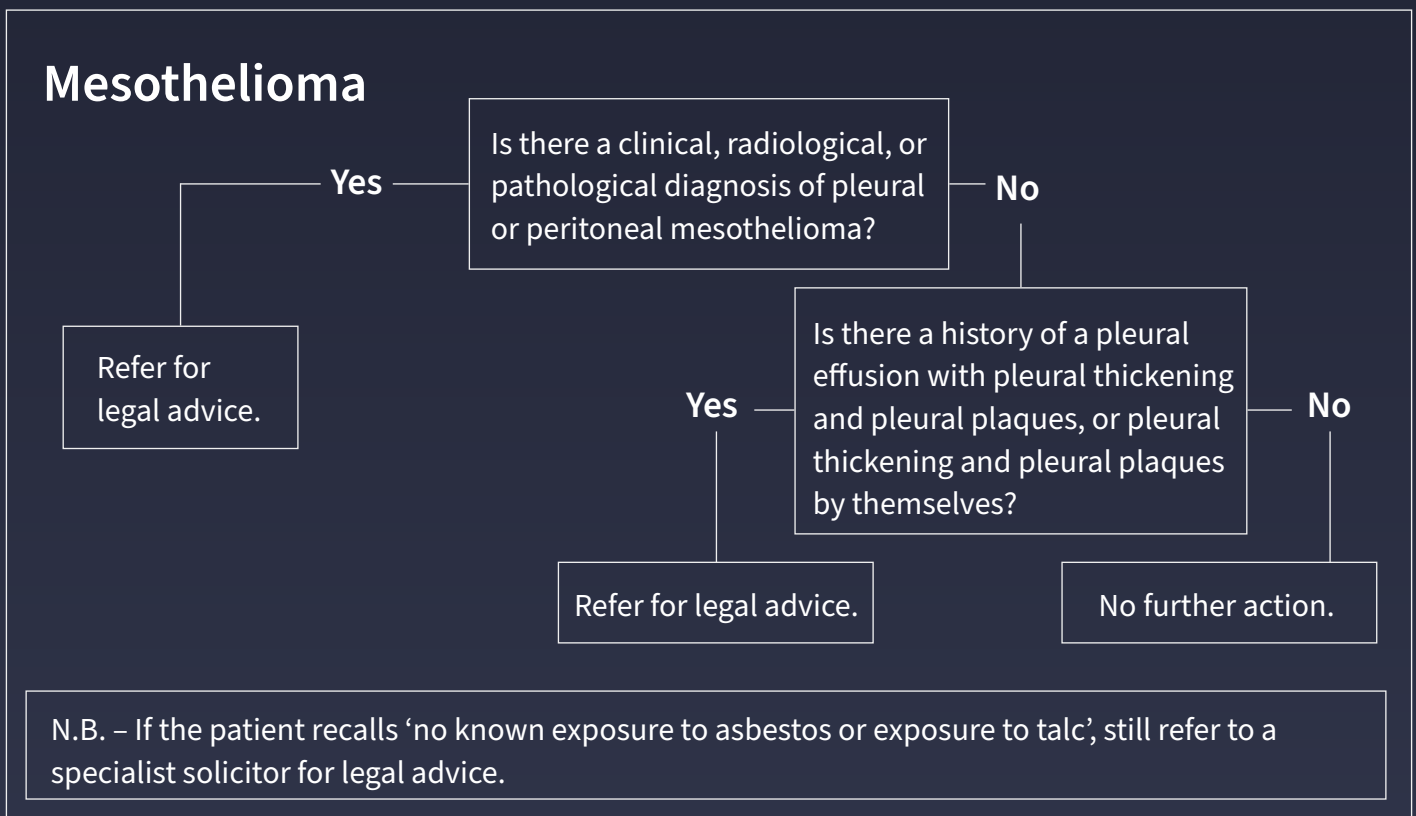

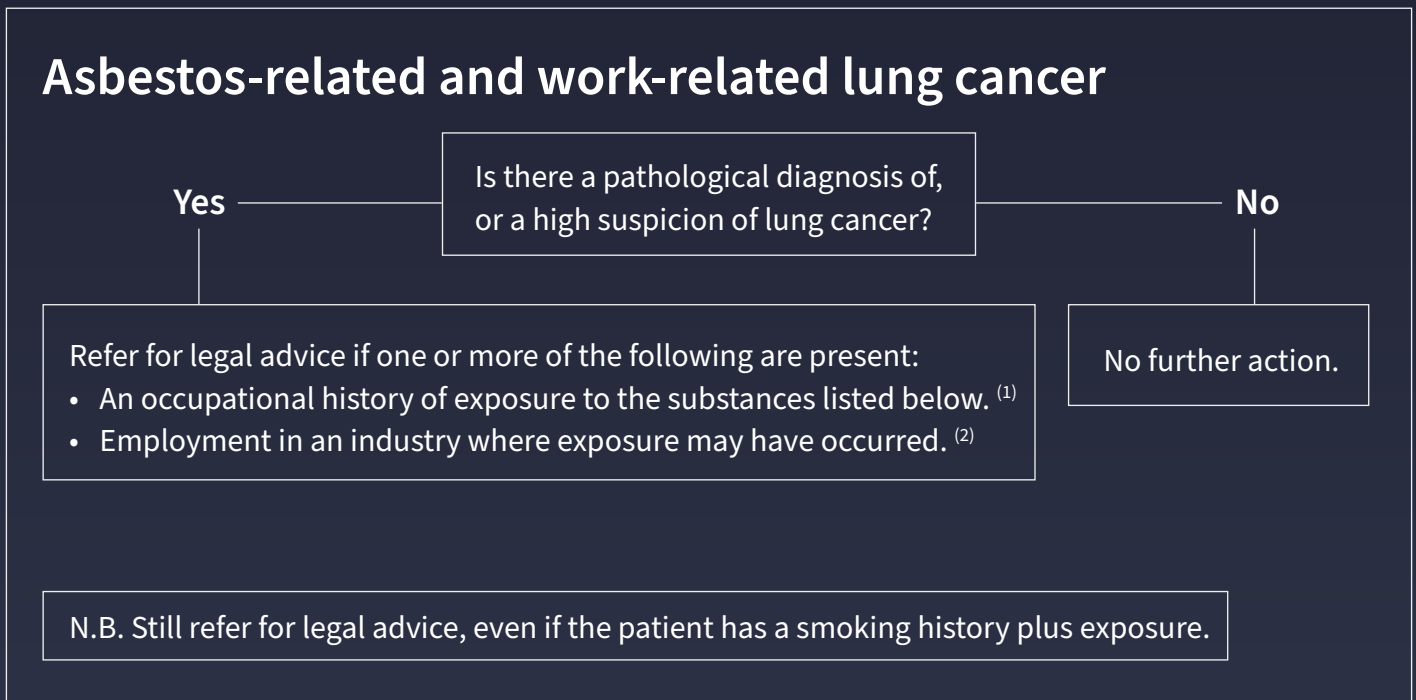

### 1. Substances

- Asbestos
- Arsenic and inorganic arsenic compounds
- Beryllium and beryllium compounds
- Cadmium and cadmium compounds, chromium (IV) compounds
- Coal gasification
- Coal-tar pitch
- Coke production
- Engine/Diesel exhaust fumes
- Haematite
- Nickel
- Silica dust and its crystalline forms (quartz)
- Welding fumes.

### 2. Industries

- Iron and steel foundries
- Acheson processing
- Aluminium production
- Armed Forces
- Construction and joinery
- Electrical and engineering
- Heating and ventilation
- Insulation
- Mining
- Painting and decorating
- Rubber manufacturing
- Transportation – including caravans, railways, shipbuilding and motor
- Tailoring
- Healthcare and education.
