Abstract Submission Guidelines

We invite submission of abstracts for presentation at the ILD-IN annual conference on 4-5th October 2026. We welcome research that has previously been submitted and/or presented at other conferences.

Abstracts must be submitted via the abstract portal on the [ILD-IN website](#) by 11:59pm on the 31st July 2026.

Guidance for abstract submission:

By submitting an abstract, you agree to the following:

- The abstract is related to ILD
- The abstract is scientifically sound and has governance and/or ethical approval (if required)
- You are a healthcare professional
- The abstract is not an advertisement, nor contains anything obscene, defamatory, libelous, unlawful or in any way actionable
- The abstract and/or poster will be made available on the ILD-IN website and social media
- All authors have seen and approved the abstract as submitted
- If your abstract is accepted, you will register for attendance to the ILD-IN annual conference 2026 to present your research as a poster and spoken presentation.

Guidance for abstract format:

Title: The title can be a maximum of **50 characters**.

Authors and affiliations: You will be asked to provide author and affiliation details within the submission process.

Do not include author details or information that identifies your place of work in the title or body of the abstract.

Body: The abstract body should be a maximum of **350 words** and should include the following sections: aims, methods, results and conclusions.

Tables, figures and references: Tables, figures and references can be included with your abstract and should be uploaded within your abstract document.

Submitting your abstract: If all required abstract submission fields have been completed, you will be able to submit your abstract. A confirmation email will be sent to you shortly after your submission.

Abstract selection

All abstracts submitted by the deadline will be considered by the committee. Abstracts will be declined if they do not meet the guidance or are deemed to be incomplete or irrelevant. The submitting author will be contacted with a decision by **24th July 2026** via email.

Presentation

If your abstract is accepted, you will need to register your attendance, bring with you and display a portrait poster in size A0 and deliver a 5-minute presentation with 5 minutes Q&A.
